Last year's W.A.T.C.H. gift was used to purchase a cabinet for the computer components of the new IT system installed in the main classroom, a desk chair for the Principal, and new furniture for the staff room including comfortable chairs, a coffee table and two end tables. Due to COVID-19 restrictions that impacted classroom arrangements, two rolling white boards and two lecterns were also purchased.

As 2020 comes to a close. it gives us time to reflect on the blessings the Lord has


